**01. Venue Location**

The Stables at Petworth House are adjacent to the entrance to Petworth House at the National Trust's Church Lodge entry point in Petworth itself. This, in turn, is next to St. Mary's Church. The postcode is GU28 0AD.

**Car Parking.** Please use either one of the Town's car parks. The venue is a 5 minute walk via Market Square and up the cobbled road (Lombard Street). With St. Mary's in front of you please cross the road using the slightly raised pedestrian crossing and turn left. The large Stables doors will be open.

There are a few Disabled Spaces outside St. Mary's and the National Trust entrance. There is room to drop passengers off here and park in the town car parks if all spaces are taken. Our stewards will be on hand to assist if required.

The auditorium is outdoors so please dress accordingly.

Fixed, unreserved seats are provided.
